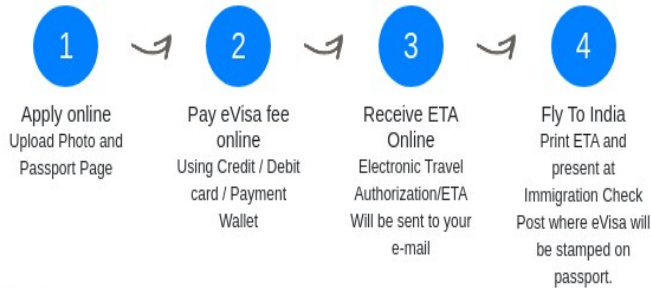

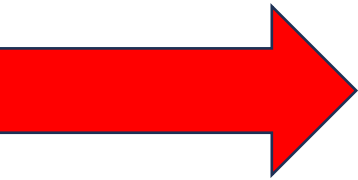

Applicant can read the countries/ nationalities who are eligible for eVisa. Greek citizen can apply for eTourist Visa, eBusiness Visa, eMedical Visa, eConference Visa, eMedicalAttendant Visa and eEmergency X Misc. Visa.

So, for these kinds of visas, there is no need to visit the Embassy and one can apply electronically as per procedure explained here.

For other type of visa, for which eVisa is not available, the applicant has to fill up application for regular visa, to be issued by the Embassy. Then he/she has to visit the Embassy with prior appointment.

Applicant may please read all instructions and other details.

The normal time of grant of eVisa is 02 to 15 days. Regarding eVisa, one can make their enquiry at eVisa help desk given here:

It must have photograph of the applicant. Take this eVisa printout along with your passport to travel to India.

At immigration counter, the immigration authority in India will paste a proper visa on the passport.
